Tournament Report:

If you like Coronation Chicken, you should have been in Cambridge at the High/Low Tournament: piles of the stuff, plus Shortbread, Fidget Pie and Carrot Cake... Familiar faces, familiar food, and familiar enjoyment plus some very welcome new arrivals who gamely mixed in with the old-timers to play some excellent tennis.

We had six pairs taking part at Cambridge University Real Tennis Club, each pair playing every other pair over the weekend, the twist being that the pairs are sorted by handicap: the highest handicap plays with the lowest handicap, the second highest with the second lowest, and so on. This created some 'interesting' manoeuvering to decide who was going to hit the ball: the better player or the one nearer the shot?

Playing six matches over two days is pretty intensive but despite some tired knees, the
